**AUTHORIZING IN REM FORECLOSURE OF
FOUR MUNICIPALLY HELD TAX SALE CERTIFICATES**

WHEREAS, NJSA 54:5-104.35 provides the authority for a governing body to proceed with the In Rem Foreclosure process on those municipally held tax sale certificates held for more than six months from the date of Tax Sale and contain real estate taxes that are unpaid for at least 21 months:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED on this 09th day of November 2021 by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Frankford that the Township Attorney is hereby authorized to proceed with In Rem Foreclosure of the Tax Sale Certificates reflected upon the certified foreclosure list, prepared by the Tax Collector and attached hereto, pursuant to the Rules of Civil Practice in the Superior Court of New Jersey.
