**RESOLUTION 2021-079**

**REFUNDING 2020 & 2021 PROPERTY TAXES ON VARIOUS PROPERTIES  
WHICH WERE GRANTED A DISABLED VETERAN TAX EXEMPTION**

**WHEREAS**, according to NJSA 54:4-3.30 et seq, which was amended by Public Law 2019, Chapter 413, states that when a veteran or a surviving spouse of a veteran or serviceperson is determined to have suffered a permanent disability being total, paraplegia, or blindness caused by their military service, that the applicant be granted a property tax exemption on their dwelling house and the lot where the house is erected, if they so occupy this property and it is considered their legal residence; and

**WHEREAS**, the Frankford Township Tax Assessor has approved the following property tax exemptions requiring a refund of taxes paid during 2021:
