AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR NEW FUEL STORAGE TANKS, ACCESSORIES, AND PIPING FOR THE INSTALLTION OF ABOVEGROUND FUEL TANKS AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT THROUGH THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Frankford Township wishes to purchase aboveground storage tanks and related equipment and material for the purposes of dispensing fuel from an authorized vendor under State of New Jersey Cooperative Purchasing Program for any State contracts entered into on behalf of the State by the Division of Purchase and Property in the Department of the Treasury; and

WHEREAS, the Township has authorization to make this purchase without the need of open competitive bidding pursuant to New Jersey Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et, seq) by virtue of State Contract No. T-0849; and

WHEREAS, the availability of the State Contract best serves the needs of the Township and the Purchasing Department recommends utilization of this contract; and

WHEREAS, the cost of this purchase shall not exceed \$84,688.50; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of Frankford Township, in the County of Sussex, and the State of New Jersey, awards a contract for the purchase of New Fuel Storage Tanks, Accessories, and Piping to Petro Mechanics, Inc., 18 Prices Lane, Lafayette, NJ 07848.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the governing body of the Township of Frankford, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.5(b), the certification of available funds, shall either certify the full maximum amount against the budget at the time the contract is awarded, or no contract amount shall be chargeable or certified until such time as the goods or services are ordered or otherwise called for prior to placing the order, and a certification of availability of funds is made by the Chief Finance Officer.
