RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKFORD COUNTY OF SUSSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP TO PARTICIPATE IN THE EQUALIS GROUP COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et. seq., authorizes contracting units to establish a Cooperative Pricing System and to enter into Cooperative Pricing Agreements for its administration; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey passed Public Law 2011, Chapter 139, that allows local contracting units to utilize national cooperative contacts as an acceptable procurement method, explained in detail in the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, Division of Local Government Services, Local Finance Notice No. LFN 2012-10, dated May 14, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Equalis Group, 5550 Granite Parkway, Suite 298, Plano, Texas 75024, a recognized and accepted cooperative purchasing organization maintains Local Cooperative Agreement Contracts which are competitively awarded through which members can make purchases; and

WHEREAS, the Equalis Group, LLC hereinafter referred to as the "Lead Agency" has offered voluntary participation in a Cooperative Purchasing System for the provision and performance of goods and services; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to enter into an agreement with Equalis Group to become a member of the Equalis Group Cooperative Purchasing System from the date of adoption of this resolution until the Township and/or Equalis Group formally terminates the cooperative membership.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township of Frankford, County of Sussex, State of New Jersey that the Township Committee hereby authorizes the Township of Frankford to participate in the Equalis Group Cooperative Purchasing Agreement and execute a Cooperative Purchasing Agreement with the Equalis Group; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Equalis Group as Lead Agency is expected to comply with the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et. seq. and all of the provisions of the revised statutes of the State of New Jersey).
