To assist our Volunteer Fire Fighters and Rescue Squad members, it is a requirement of our Township Ordinance that your home properly displays your house number. Please make every effort to comply so our responders can find your home in case of emergency. Forms are available in our office, from the local Blue Ridge Rescue Squad for the required reflective address signs. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

12-3 NUMBERING OF HOUSES AND LOTS.

12-3.4 Duty to Display.

Every property owner in the Township shall cause to be affixed and displayed the assigned street number on every lot containing a permanent structure in the Township as indicated on the aforementioned list, such affixed and displayed street number shall be maintained at all times in compliance with the provisions of this section. (Ord. No. 93-8 § 23-4)

12-3.5 Size.

Each digit of the street number shall be a minimum of three (3) inches in height, and a minimum of two (2) inches in width. (Ord. No. 93-8 § 23-5)

12-3.6 Placement.

The assigned street numbers shall be permanently and conspicuously placed on the primary structure or other conspicuous permanent location such as a pole or mailbox so as to be clearly visible during daylight and night time hours from the center of the abutting traveled roadway. (Ord. No. 93-8 § 23-6)

12-3.7 Color.

The color of the numbers shall be in sharp contrast to the background color and be constructed of reflective material to permit the identification during daylight and nighttime hours. (Ord. No. 93-8 § 23-7)

12-3.8 New Construction.

The owner of any vacant lot shall obtain the appropriate assigned and designated street number from the Township Tax Assessor and affix and display this number in accordance with the provisions of this section prior to any building permit being issued. Any person applying for a building permit on a lot with an existing building must provide proof of signage prior to the issuance of a building permit. (Ord. No. 93-8 § 23-8; Ord. No. 2008-07)

12-3.9 Penalty.

Any person who violates a provision of this section shall, upon conviction, be liable for a penalty not exceeding fifty (\$50.00) dollars. A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day on which a violation occurs or continues. The Code Enforcement Officer or a designee appointed by the Township Committee is the designated enforcement officer. (Ord. No. 93-8 § 23-9; Ord. No. 2008-07)
